KinKeeper Chooser supports family communication and thoughtful human judgment. It does not automate decision-making and does not provide legal advice.

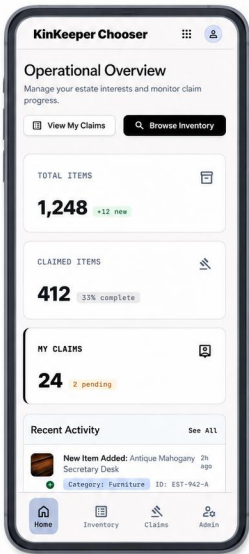

How It Works

- 1 Gather** — A family admin creates a private workspace and invites family members.
- 2 Upload** — Easily take and upload photos from a phone or computer.
- 3 Organize** — Sort items into folders, categories, and tags.
- 4 Request** — Family members note the items they hope to keep, share meaning, and set priorities.
- 5 Finalize** — The family admin reviews requests, balances overlapping interests, and notes final placement.

Everyone Has a Role

KinKeeper Chooser supports every part of the estate process with clear tools for each family role.



Family Member

Browse the catalog, note the items that mean the most to you, share stories, and view final updates.



Helper / Organizer

Help build the catalog by uploading photos, organizing items, and assisting others with the list.



Family Admin

Invite family members, review overlapping requests, make final care decisions, and coordinate the shared workspace.



Simple Organization



Folders: Organized by rooms, areas, or collections. Each item lives in one specific folder.



Categories: Types of belongings such as Furniture, Jewelry, or Books. Each item can have one category.



Tags: Flexible searchable labels. Add as many as needed.



The Request Process

Family members can submit a request, choose a priority from 1 to 5, and add a personal note about sentimental history or practical needs.

If more than one person requests the same piece, the family admin can review requests side by side and either award the item, divide a set, or hold it for family discussion.



Priority Guide: 1 = Nice to have | 5 = Deeply meaningful.

Priorities help the administrator understand what matters most; they do not automatically distribute items.



Getting Started

- 1 Open the invitation email.
- 2 Sign in securely with email.
- 3 Browse uploaded items.
- 4 Note the items that speak to you and explain why.
- 5 Check back for updates.
